OVERVIEW OF JOURNEYS

COACH, DELUXE & VISTA DOME JOURNEYS:

Ticket price includes journey. To dine, add a breakfast voucher for 9:00 a.m. departures, and a lunch/dinner voucher for 12:30, 3:30 or 6:30 p.m. departures. Breakfast vouchers include one breakfast entree from the 403 Grill menu and coffee, tea or a soft drink. Lunch/dinner vouchers include one lunch/dinner entree from the 403 Grill menu and a soft drink. Alcoholic beverages are additional and available throughout your journey. Any additional purchases plus corresponding waitstaff gratuity are and due at time of service. Journeys begin at the Santa Fe Depot and travel through the spectacular Royal Gorge and back. All classes of service have access to our open-air car. Trips last approximately 2 hours. REMINDER: An 18% Gratuity will be added to each prepaid meal voucher

FIRST CLASS LUNCH OR FIRST CLASS DINNER JOURNEYS:

Ticket price includes journey and three-course dining experience plus a glass of sparkling wine, salad, bread and butter, main entree and chef's choice dessert. All beverages - soft drinks and alcoholic beverages - are additional and available throughout journey. Additional purchases plus corresponding waitstaff gratuity is additional and due at time of service. Journeys begin at the Santa Fe Depot and travel through the spectacular Royal Gorge and back. All journeys begin at the Santa Fe Depot. First Class Lunch Trips last approximately 2 hours. First Class Dinner Trips last approximately 3 hours. NOTE: First-Class Lunch and Dinner train guests must be 8 years or older, and all clients must be able to navigate 14 steps into the Dome by themselves, this is not a wheelchair accessible class of service. REMINDER: An 18% Gratuity will be added to the dining portion of each First Class Lunch and Dinner journey.

CLASSES OF SERVICE

VISTA DOME:

Modern glass observation dome cars were introduced to the rails in 1945 as a means of allowing passengers in a booth style seating a better view of the passing scenery through a raised panoramic mostly- glass enclosure (dome). All total, 236 dome cars of various configurations were constructed over the next decade. In 1954 and 1955 thirty full-length domes were designed and built by the Budd and Pullman Company's, representing the pinnacle of this design. We are very fortunate to have been able to acquire these unique full-length dome cars, renovating them to our deluxe comfort standards. On our railroad they are perfectly suited to take-in the sheer verticality that our route through the gorge has to offer! *This car has 14 steps up into the Dome. It is not accessible to passengers in wheelchairs.

DELUXE:

With front row views of this dazzling canyon, a ride through the Royal Gorge is a sure way to relax your mind and nurture your soul. Deluxe Class has a decidedly social feel with our 1950's parlor room inspired interior and the table-styled seating focused on stunning views, but with the flexibility to move about the wooden paneled car. We have remodeled five Deluxe cars and each one is unique in its own way. Plus, you are just a quick walk away from experiencing the outdoor grandeur of the Royal Gorge aboard the open-air observation car.

COACH:

Relax into comfortably cushioned high-back seats with expansive picture windows that showcase the pristine views throughout Colorado's grandest canyon. Your trip is not complete without taking a stroll out to the open-air observation car. This is where the up-close-and- personal nature of this 1,200-foot deep and oh-so-narrow canyon will remind you of the awesome beauty produced by our good friend, Mother Nature. This car does not have a table, but a tray will be provided upon request in order to enjoy your meal options aboard the train.



FUN FACTS

At its grandest height, the Royal Gorge is 1,200 feet deep - comparable to the Empire State Building. At its most narrow, it is only 30 feet wide.

The Hanging Bridge is a modern engineering marvel. It cost \$11,759 in 1879, a princely sum in those days. Although it has been strengthened over the years, this unique structure has served on a main rail line for over 118 years.

This historic rail line began service in 1880 and ceased operation on July 26, 1967. It was resurrected by a Colorado family, former owners of the Georgetown Loop Railroad, in 1998. What began as a small operation with just five coach cars has grown into one of the busiest destination travel experiences in the Rocky Mountain West. Today, more than 210,000 people ride and dine aboard the Royal Gorge Route Railroad each year.

President Teddy Roosevelt rode the train through the Royal Gorge in 1905, when he declared it was "the trip that bankrupts the English language."

The Royal Gorge Route Railroad has more observation dome cars than any other railway in North America.

DIRECTIONS

Travel to Canon City, Colorado on Highway 50, turn south on Third Street to the Santa Fe Depot. Shopping and ticket pick up resides in the Santa Fe Depot.

Pricing:

Tour groups of 20 or more, the Royal Gorge Route offers a \$10.00 per ticket discount in all classes of service. This offer is not valid for special events throughout the year including but not limited to Santa Express, Holiday Train, New Year's Eve Trains, Murder Mystery Trains, Valentine's Day Trains, Easter Trains, Mother's Day Trains, Memorial Day Weekend, Fourth of July Weekend and Labor Day Weekend.

Group Sizes:

Tour group reservations that drops below 20 people will be charged the current individual rate that is listed on the train's website. All discounted tickets will still be subject to the current historic preservation fee.

Cancellation policy:

If a reservation is cancelled for any reason within 60 days of departure, a \$20.00 per ticket fee will be charged for the cancellation. Any reservation that is cancelled within 30 days of departure, including any and all "no-shows" or late ticket pick-ups, the entire amount will be forfeited. No refunds will be given. Train tickets that have not been picked up within 60 minutes of train departure may be resold at the Royal Gorge Route Railroad's sole discretion. No refunds will be issued, regardless of any resale.

Rescheduling:

If a tour group rescheduling request is received more than 72 hours prior to departure, and space is available for the group at the requested date and time, a \$5.00/ticket additional fee will be assessed in coach, deluxe, or vista dome, and a \$45.00/ticket additional fee will apply for first class lunch or dinner. Any rescheduled reservation may not extend beyond one-year of the original reservation. If rescheduled date is impacted by a rate increase, guests will be responsible for the adjustment in rate.

Additional Policies:

- Groups MUST arrive at the Santa Fe Depot at least 1 hour prior to departure.
- Handicap service requests MUST be communicated in writing to the Royal Gorge Route Railroad Director of Sales at least 48 hours prior to departure and, as handicap space is limited, it is not guaranteed.
- Specific seats are not guaranteed, unless chartering a car or the entire train. Due to the number of seats reserved for your group, seating is limited to those designated seats; therefore, guests must fill every seat. Non-reserved group seats will be made available for sale to the public unless the entire car or train has been chartered.
- Rates, times, and consist are subject to change without notice.
- No outside food, drink or weapons are permitted on the train.
- Strollers and car seats are not permitted on the train.
- Pets are NOT allowed on board the train, with the exception of licenced service dogs, which are never allowed on train seats.
- Royal Gorge Route Railroad is not responsible for any loss or damage to personal items left on the train or in the station before, during or after an event.
- The client agrees to pay for any damages caused by group members to the premises before, during or after the event. In the event damages do occur, the group will be charged for repair and / or replacement.
- Royal Gorge Route Railroad reserves the right to refuse service to anyone, or remove anyone from the train who, in the judgment of Royal Gorge Route Railroad staff, appears intoxicated or is rude or disorderly, or acting in an unsafe manner. Disembarking of passengers, EXCEPT AT DESIGNATED STOPS OR, IN THE CASE OF AN EMERGENCY, is prohibited.
- Royal Gorge Route Railroad is not responsible for delays or cancellations of excursions due to the weather, random acts of terrorism, sabotage by vandals, 'acts of God,' or mechanical difficulties.

WAIVER OF LIABILITY

The Canon City and Royal Gorge Railroad, LLC ("CCRGR") is a small scenic railroad that runs through the Royal Gorge in southern Colorado. The CCRGR is not a common carrier. You have chosen to ride the CCRGR because you would like to see the scenic beauty of the Royal Gorge while experiencing what it was like to ride a train in the early 1900's. To provide that experience, the CCRGR uses authentic vintage equipment that may not be as safe as the modern passenger trains with which you may be more familiar. To provide this experience, we need to receive this Waiver of Liability from you. The intent of this Waiver of Liability is to extinguish all liability the CCRGR might otherwise have to you (or to your estate or your surviving relatives) in the event you are injured or killed while riding the CCRGR.

Definitions: The terms "CCRGR," "us," and "we" mean the Canon City and Royal Gorge Railroad, LLC, Royal Gorge Express, LLC, Rock and Rail, LLC, and any of their employees, agents, independent contractors, managers, members, owners, officers, directors, shareholders, owners, parents, subsidiaries, assigns, other related entities and insurers. The word "you" includes you, any minor children traveling with you, and any other adult in your party for whom you have purchased tickets. The word "train" means all the equipment used by the CCRGR (tracks, cars, engines, and related equipment) as well as the station and boarding areas. The phrase "riding the CCRGR" includes any activity on CCRGR's property, including but not limited to boarding or dismounting from the train, interacting with other passengers and staff, eating and drinking on the train and walking around the train, the platform, station and depot, and all other activities related to or ancillary to these activities.

Risk of Injury or Death: Because the CCRGR is an old train, accidents may happen. The CCRGR may be negligent. Other passengers or third parties may be negligent. The train may derail or run over you; you may be overcome by fumes or smoke from the engine; you may slip and fall; there may be adverse weather; falling rocks and debris; errors in food storage or preparation; improper use of equipment; equipment failure; defective equipment; exposure to viruses or bacteria, and other illnesses; entrapment of body parts; allergic reactions; other medical conditions and reactions; emotional distress; you may be maimed or otherwise seriously injured; you may even be killed. In addition, the Royal Gorge is a remote and undeveloped Canyon subject to flash flooding, landslides and rockfall. Communication is difficult. If there is an accident, it may be difficult to call for help, and it may take time for emergency medical personnel and rescue personnel to arrive at the scene. This description of risks is NOT complete and your participation in this activity may include other dangers and risks not expressly listed.

Risk of Transmission of Infectious Disease: You hereby acknowledge the inherent risk of transmission or exposure to the COVID-19 virus (aka "Coronavirus"), or any other infectious diseases, and agree to indemnify and hold harmless CCRGR and its employees and agents, from any loss, liability, damage, or cost, including attorney's fees, that you may incur arising out of or related to any illness or death caused by an infectious disease contracted after riding CCRGR's train, or that you transmit to others, whether caused by the negligence of CCRGR or otherwise. You agree to take all reasonable precautions in preventing the spread of any infectious diseases, and you affirm that you are not currently and have not in the previous three weeks exhibited any Coronavirus, common cold, or flu-like symptoms, including but not limited to fever, cough, sore throat, respiratory illness, or difficulty breathing. If you have any signs or symptoms of infection, or if you have had them or cared for or been around someone who is infected, you agree to stay home. You also agree to comply with all Executive Orders and guidelines issued by the Governor of the State of Colorado, the Colorado Department of Health & Environment, and the Federal Government with respect to COVID-19 and other infectious diseases.

Waiver of Liability: If you are injured, including contracting an illness or death, while riding the CCRGR, you agree that you will not sue the CCRGR or bring any legal action against CCRGR with respect to any claims and causes of action of any nature, whether currently known or unknown, including, but not limited to claims of negligence, negligence per se, strict liability, product liability, premises liability, property damage, torts, emotional distress, breach of warranty, misrepresentation, non-disclosure, state and federal statutory claims, unfair trade or business practices, breach of contract, and all other claims for relief and causes of action. If you are killed while riding the CCRGR, your estate or surviving relatives may not sue us either. In other words, you are waiving any claim that you may have, or any claim that anyone may assert as a result of your death (such as your estate or surviving relatives) if you are injured, contract an illness, suffer damage or are killed while riding the CCRGR.

Indemnification: You agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless CCRGR from and against all liability, costs, property loss, medical bills, loss of income, attorney's fees, expenses, liens, and damages of any kind or nature whatsoever, and from any suits, claims, administrative actions, and demands, whether or not in litigation, arising out of, or related to, your involvement in riding the CCRGR. This provision shall afford the CCRGR a right to pursue a claim. Your indemnification obligations continue even when you are done riding the CCRGR.

Assumption of Risk: You agree and understand there are risks with riding the CCRGR, including, but not limited to, the fault and negligence of the CCRGR, the fault and negligence of other guests and third parties, and all risks outlined above. By signing this document, you recognize that property loss, injury, illness and death are all possible. Recognizing the risks and dangers, you voluntarily choose to participate in and expressly assume all risks and dangers of involvement in riding the CCRGR, whether or not described above, known or unknown, inherent, or otherwise.

Attorney's Fees/Jurisdiction: If, notwithstanding what is said above, you sue us anyway (or your estate or surviving relatives sue us), you (on behalf of yourself or your estate and surviving relatives) agree in advance to reimburse the CCRGR for all costs and attorney's fees incurred defending against such claim – because the purpose of this Waiver of Liability is to prevent such lawsuits. In addition, any such lawsuit must be filed in the Colorado District Court for Fremont County (where the CCRGR operates), and you agree to waive your right to a trial by jury. This Waiver of Liability is governed by the laws of the State of Colorado. If you sue us, all issues will be governed by Colorado law.

Minor/Third Party Acknowledgement: In the case of a minor passenger (under 18 years), and any other person in your party for whom tickets were purchased together, the undersigned acknowledges that he/she is not only signing this Waiver of Liability on his/her behalf, but that he/she is also signing on behalf of the minor and other individuals and that they are bound by all the terms of this Waiver of Liability. Additionally, by signing this Waiver of Liability on behalf of a minor, you are also waiving rights on behalf of the minor that the minor otherwise may have. By signing this Waiver of Liability, you represent, under penalty of fraud, that you are at least 18 years of age. If signing on behalf of a of a minor or any other individual, you represent, under penalty of fraud, that you are the legal parent or guardian of the minor passenger and/or that you have authority to sign for all individuals in your party.

Medical Care: You authorize CCRGRR to call for medical care for you and to transport you to a medical facility or hospital if, in the opinion of CCRGRR, medical attention is needed. You agree to pay all costs of such medical care and transportation, and to defend and indemnify CCRGR for such costs. Undersigned represents that he/she has sufficient insurance to cover any loss, injury, or damage sustained by him/her or third party.

Miscellaneous: You further agree and understand that: (a) You will not engage in any activities prohibited by any applicable laws, statutes, regulations, ordinances, and CCRGRR's rules; (b) if you violate any laws, statutes, regulations, ordinances or CCRGRR's rules, you may be removed and will not be allowed to return; (c) You represent that you are medically, physically, and mentally fit to ride the CCRGRR; and (d) you understand and acknowledge that this Agreement is a contract and shall be binding to the fullest extent permitted by law. If any part of this Agreement is deemed to be unenforceable, the remaining terms shall be an enforceable contract. It is your intent that this agreement shall be binding upon your assignees, subrogors, distributors, heirs, next of kin, executors, and personal representatives.

Photo Release: You consent and authorize CCRGRR to use your testimonials, photograph images and video images for use in any advertising materials, including television, printed marketing material, Internet sites, exhibits, and promotions.
